DIRECTIONS to the GROVER HOUSE – our friends of the **Navesink Maritime Heritage Association** are graciously offering us this historic space, even though it is still under renovation.

Parkway: Ex.109 = Route 520 East – take the first left – via the jughandle after the Lyncroft Academy bus station (onto Half Mile Road) – go to the end, take a left at West Front Street – the Grover House comes after Sterling Court, the third street. There is a large sign and plenty of parking in front.

Route 35 North: I found this to be easiest: Before you get to Red Bank, take the jughandle to Route 520 West (= Newman Springs Road). Before the Lyncroft Academy Bus Station, take a right onto Half Mile Road. Continue as above.

Route 35 South: After the bridge into Red Bank, follow the signs to Front Street. Go West on Front Street until you see Half Mile Road on your left. Continue as above.

As usual, we will have a **Featured Leader-Performer(s)**. Ingrid Heldt and Isis Ra, the organizers, will also participate, and so can you: Similarly to the **Circle of Song Stage** at our NJ Friends of Clearwater Festivals, there will be **opportunities for audience members to take a turn or two to play – or to sing along** – bring your instrument. But if you wish, just come and listen.

We encourage songs about the environment and sing-along songs, but you can do or request others.

The suggested donation of \$3-\$7 is still split between NJ Friends of Clearwater's free Annual Festival (our 43rd in 2018) and Pastor Sony's work on behalf of the homeless and the hungry in Asbury Park.
