DIRECTIONS:

Parkway: Ex.98 = Rte. 138 East to end – north on Rte. 35 – right at 1st light = Belmar Blvd. – right at 1st light = Rte. 71 – look on right

Route 35 South: Cross bridge into Belmar – take 4th left (at Windmill/Dairy Queen), cross 16th Ave. = Belmar Blvd. – look on right

Main Street So. (Train Station): Right on 16th Ave. = Belmar Blvd. – left on Rte. 71 – look right (ab. 7 blocks from Train St.).
